

**THE
PROVINCIAL EMPLOYEES' SOCIAL
SECURITY (MEDICAL ADVISER'S
QUALIFICATIONS)
RULES, 1966**

No. LAB-m-n/ 15/SS/66, dated 12th October, 1966. With reference to the; Government of West Pakistan, Labour Department's Notification No. SS-V-1/65, dated the 25th October, 1965, and in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 79 of the Provincial Employees' Social Security Ordinance, 1965 (West Pakistan Ordinance No. X of 1965), the Governor of West Pakistan is pleased to make the following rules:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Provincial Employees' Social Security (Medical Adviser's Qualifications) Rules, 1966.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Qualifications of Medical Adviser.—No person shall be appointed as the Medical Adviser unless he—

- (a) holds a M.B.B.S. degree conferred by a University in Pakistan, or a qualification recognised by Government as equivalent or superior to such qualification; and
- (b) has had not less than five years experience of organization or administration connected with the practice of medicine; and
- (c) is registered as a medical practitioner under the Medical Council Ordinance, 1962.
